

National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS)

Institutions are required to inform prospective student and parent borrowers that federal loans will be submitted to the National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS) and will be accessible by guaranty agencies, lenders and institutions determined to be authorized users of the data system.

Southern Crescent Technical College submits all loan information to NSLDS. This information will be accessible to guaranty agencies, lenders, and institutions determined to be authorized users of the data system.

The **National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS)** is the **U.S. Department of Education's central database**, and the information it holds is now primarily accessed by students and borrowers through the StudentAid.gov website. The separate public-access NSLDS website has been retired for individual use, and StudentAid.gov now serves as the main portal for managing federal student aid information.

How to Access Your NSLDS Data on StudentAid.gov

To view the information previously found on the NSLDS student portal, follow these steps:

1. **Go to the [official Federal Student Aid website](#)** at StudentAid.gov.
2. **Click "Log In"** and sign in using your FSA ID username and password. This is the same account you use to complete the FAFSA® form.
3. **Navigate to your account dashboard** to view your federal student loan and grant information, including:
 - Loan and/or grant amounts.
 - Outstanding balances.
 - Loan statuses (e.g., in-school, grace period, repayment).
 - Disbursement details.
 - Your loan servicer(s) information and contact details.

You can also download a plain text file (.txt) of your complete federal loan, grant, and enrollment information directly from your StudentAid.gov account.
