



## Consumer Economics AS Degree (CE33)- 62 Credit Hours

**Program Description:**

The Associate of Science degree in Consumer Economics is a transferable program of study developed in collaboration with the University of Georgia's College of Family and Consumer Sciences. The program includes TCSG general education courses that satisfy all University of Georgia core curriculum requirements, as well as Consumer Economics major courses that satisfy requirements toward UGA's Bachelor of Science in Family and Consumer Science. [1] Graduates of the program receive the Associate of Science degree in consumer Economics from Southern Crescent Technical College and, provided they meet the admissions requirements in effect at the time of application, may begin taking upper-level coursework at UGA immediately upon transfer.

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING TRANSFER TO UGA**

To qualify to transfer the A.S. in Consumer Economics to UGA, students must:

- **Submit the Undergraduate Application for Admission to UGA during the last semester at SCTC prior to completion of the associate's degree but before the UGA application deadline (see [www.admissions.uga.edu](http://www.admissions.uga.edu) for deadline). Students whose last semester at SCTC is a spring semester must meet the appropriate deadline, but may submit a form requesting a file completion deadline of June 1. This would allow the term enrolled to count towards the hours and grades needed for admission. UGA admissions is on Griffin campus the first Tuesday of each month to advise transfer students.**
- **Earn a minimum cumulative GPA and transferable hours that meet UGA requirements at the time of transfer.**
- **Complete the Consumer Economics A.S. degree program (60-63 credit hours) at SCTC.**
- **Be in good standing at SCTC and have no conduct or behavior issues when reviewed by UGA Admissions.**
- **Pass all courses identified in the curriculum of this program with a grade of C or higher.**
