Film Technology Associate of Applied Science degree program will train competent entry-level Film/Video Production technicians who can successfully get an entry-level job in the film video production industry or continue with their education goals in one of the other Film Production program areas. Subject matter includes basic training in occupational areas of interest, i.e. Electrical & Lighting, Grip & Rigging, On-Set Production Assistant, Hair & Makeup, Set Construction & Scenic. Emphasizing competencies in production protocols, the pre-production, post-production process and crew responsibilities. Hands on labs provide students with real world Film and TV production simulations.
