Program Description:

The FIE3- Fire & Emergency Services Occupation degree program was designed for individuals currently employed in the public safety areas of fire service and emergency medical services seeking a degree for promotional purposes. Our FIE3 is not an entry level option. Prospective students already certified or licensed as Firefighters who wish to complete degree requirements may receive prior learning credits with documentation. Southern Crescent Technical College can only grant prior learning credits for ProBoard (NPQ) National Professional Qualifications and International Fire Service Accreditation Congress (IFSAC) certificates. For these certifications to be accepted, they must have the proper visible and legible seals and certification numbers.
