



Paramedicine Diploma (PT12)- 57 Credit Hours

Program Description:

The Paramedicine diploma program provides students for a dynamic and advanced role within the Emergency Medical Services (EMS) profession. This program will provide students with the complex knowledge and skills necessary to provide patient care and transportation and function as part of a comprehensive EMS response, under medical oversight as a Paramedic. This program combines rigorous academic coursework with extensive hands-on training to develop the clinical, technical and decision-making skills necessary for effective emergency response. Students will learn to assess patients, administer medications, perform advanced airway management and use life-saving equipment under the guidance of experienced instructors and medical professionals.
