### Program Description:

The Phlebotomy Technician program educates students to collect blood and process blood and body fluids. Phlebotomy technicians typically work in concert with clinical laboratory personnel and other health care providers in hospitals or other health care facilities. Topics covered include human anatomy, anatomical terminology, venipuncture, and clinical practice. Upon successful completion (or transfer in) of ALHS 1011, ALHS 1090, ALHS 1040, ENG 1010, and COMP 1000 students must apply to the program-ready list.
