Admission Criteria for Radiologic Technology Degree (RT23)

Admission to Health Sciences and Nursing degree and certificate programs are based on a competitive selection process. There are minimum requirements for admission to individual Health Sciences and Nursing programs, and meeting minimum requirements does not guarantee admission to the program. Be sure to review the [Competitive Selection Program Statistics](#).

Grading standards for Radiologic Technology courses are very stringent. For students to progress to the next course of study, a minimum grade of C must be achieved in every RADT course. **Students must also maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0 to remain in the program.**

Competitive Selection Requirements

- Must complete the eight (8) required courses and labs with a minimum grade of “C” or higher and have at least a 3.0 competitive GPA.
 - ENGL 1101, ALHS 1090, MATH 1111 or 1101 or 1103, SPCH 1101, BIOL 2113, BIOL 2113L, BIOL 2114, and BIOL 2114L are used to calculate the competitive GPA.
- All students must submit test scores from the HESI A2 Examination with a minimum score of 70. Scores cannot be more than a year old. It is strongly recommended that applicants take the HESI A2 **on the SCTC campus** to ensure the exam meets all required components. If the exam does not meet all requirements, **it will not be accepted**, and the applicant will be deemed **ineligible for admission**. Program faculty will **NOT** accept late submissions of Allied Health Applications, transfer credits, or HESI A2 Exam results.
