## Admission Criteria for Registered Nursing (NU43)

Admission to Health Sciences, Nursing degree and certificate programs is based on a competitive selection process. There are minimum requirements for admission to individual Health Sciences and Nursing programs, and meeting minimum requirements does not guarantee admission to the program. ### Competitive Selection Application

- Applications for **Spring admission** are accepted August 1-31 of each calendar year. This program only accepts students one time per calendar year.

### Competitive Selection Requirements

- Must complete the nine (9) required courses and labs with a minimum grade of “C” or higher and have at least a 3.0 competitive GPA
  - ENGL 1101, ENGL 1102, PSYC 1101, PSYC 2103, with a “C” or better
  - MATH 1111 or 1103 or 1101, BIOL 2113, BIOL 2113L, BIOL 2114, and BIOL 2114L with a “B” or better.
  - Choose ONE Fine Arts: ARTS 1101, ENGL 2130, HUMN 1101, THEA or MUSC 1101 with a “C” or better
- Submit current HESI A2 scores (minimum score of 70 is required for this program). Scores cannot be older than one year at the time of application.
  - Applicant must earn a 70 minimum score. This exam comprises seven separate tests that measure abilities, skills, knowledge and attitudes important for success in the program and career choice.
  - HESI A2 Exam maximum of two (2) attempts allowed per calendar year. **Please note** that the HESI A2 may only be taken **twice per calendar year**, and scores are valid for **one year** from the test date. It is *strongly recommended* that applicants take the HESI A2 **on the SCTC campus** to ensure the exam meets all required components. If the exam does not meet all requirements, **it will not be accepted**, and the applicant will be deemed **ineligible for admission**. A copy of the highest earned HESI A2 Score Report must be attached to the program application. Students may schedule the exam through [Continuing Education](#)

### Candidate Selection Process

Selection criteria based on a formula using the combined information:

- ✓ GPA (minimum 3.0 required for general education and occupational courses)
- ✓ HESI A2 score (minimum of 70 required to apply to the nursing program)
- ✓ Program application date- Meeting requirements does not guarantee admission into the nursing program. Nursing Program Application dates vary. Please consult with the Allied Health Programs office for more information. Classroom spaces will be filled using the highest scores downward until the maximum enrollment total is reached.
- ✓ Allow 3-4 weeks from the program deadline date to receive acceptance or denial letter. All acceptance/denial emails will be sent to the student’s Southern Crescent Technical College email account.

**Note:** If a student changes his/her declared major from ASN Program to a different diploma or degree program, and then back to the ASN program, the latest program application date will be used to determine placement.
