Admission Criteria for Surgical Technology Degree (ST13)

Admission to Health Sciences and Nursing degree and certificate programs are based on a competitive selection process. There are minimum requirements for admission to individual Health Sciences and Nursing programs, and meeting minimum requirements does not guarantee admission to the program. Be sure to review the [Competitive Selection Program Statistics](#). Grading standards for the Surgical Technology Program are very stringent. For students to progress to the next course of study, a minimum grade of "C" must be achieved in every Surgical Technology course.

Competitive Selection Deadline

- The Surgical Technology program will admit once each year at the Griffin Campus.
- The Surgical Technology program is a daytime only program.
- The deadline to apply for Competitive Selection is the last day of the Summer Term. The program cohort begins each Spring Semester (January). Applications deadline is the last day of Summer semester with a Spring semester cohort start date.

Competitive Selection Requirements

- Must complete the eight (6) required courses and labs with a minimum grade of C or higher. There is no minimum GPA required.
 - ENGL 1101, PSYC 1101, MATH 1111, ALHS 1090, BIOL 2113, BIOL 2113L must be completed before the deadline.
 - BIOL 2114, BIOL 2114L, BIOL 2117, BIOL 2117L, Area IV elective and additional 3 general core credit must be completed before the start of the Spring cohort.
- Submit current HESI A2 scores (minimum score of 70 is required for this program). Scores cannot be older than one year at the time of application.
 - Applicant must earn a 70 minimum score.
 - HESI A2 Exam maximum of two (2) attempts allowed per calendar year. **Please note** that the HESI A2 may only be taken **twice per calendar year**, and scores are valid for **one year** from the test date. It is *strongly recommended* that applicants take the HESI A2 **on the SCTC campus** to ensure the exam meets all required components. If the exam does not meet all requirements, **it will not be accepted**, and the applicant will be deemed **ineligible for admission**. A copy of the highest earned HESI A2 Score Report must be attached to the program application. Students may schedule the exam through Continuing Education.
- Allow 4-6 weeks from the program deadline date to receive acceptance or denial letter.
