

A LETTER FROM OUR PRESIDENT

As you will see in the pages of this report, Southern Crescent Technical College has experienced continued success over the last year and remains at the forefront of technical and adult education in the state of Georgia. This year we have proudly upheld our commitment to the citizens of our eight-county service area to provide them with the necessary skills and knowledge to enter the workforce while assisting them as they pursue their educational, career, and personal goals. Through our mission of workforce development, Southern Crescent Technical College takes pride in building strong students, strong careers, and strong communities.

BUILDING STRONG STUDENTS

The faculty and staff have worked extremely hard to help the College build strong students for life and work and this annual report illustrates the tremendous work that is being done on behalf of our students. Each year we update you on the many successes of the past year, and I am pleased to share with you a few of the highlights of Fiscal Year 2019. Recent reports indicate that Southern Crescent Technical College had a 28.6% increase in the number of graduates, a 14.7% increase in the number of awards conferred, a 7.2% increase in the graduation rate, and a 32.4% increase in the number of dual enrollment students from last year. As you can see, our commitment to student success has never been greater.

BUILDING STRONG CAREERS

Preparing our students for the workforce remains at the core of our mission, and career placement continues to be one of our top proirites at Southern Crescent Technical College, I am proud to report that the total placement rate for Fiscal Year 2019 remained steady at 98.9%, and our in-field placement rate rose to 87.7%, an increase of 3.7% over last year. In addition, we have accepted the responsibility to assure that the necessary elements are in place to serve the diverse education and training needs of our community. Through innovative means of instruction and information access, Southern Crescent Technical College specializes in offering our students every opportunity for success. Whether students are traditional, face to face, online, adult education, or high school dual enrollment, the faculty and staff are committed to promoting strong career goals. By responding to the workforce needs of our business and industry partners, the College continues to develop new programs to stimulate Georgia's economic growth and development to meet the workforce demands of this area.

BUILDING STRONG COMMUNITIES

This past year has been a time of growth as we continued to serve the educational needs of our communities and the workforce needs of area



industry. At Southern Crescent Technical College we are fourtnate that our external partners continue to lend their support. This past year, Quad Graphics, the U.S. Department of Agriculture, and the Dart Foundation all provided financial assistance, resulting in a boost to new programs on the Flint River Campus. 
MISSION STATEMENT






