

### COMMERCIAL TRUCK DRIVING

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Thank you for your interest in SCTC's Commercial Truck Driving Program!

### **Program Description**

The Commercial Truck Driving certificate program provides basic training in the principles and skills of commercial truck operations. The program is based on the definition of a truck driver as one who operates a commercial motor vehicle of all different sizes and descriptions on all types of roads. At the completion of the program, the student is administered the Georgia CDL Skills exam. Applicants are accepted as Full-Time students into the Commercial Truck Driving program for the spring, summer and fall semesters and are also accepted in the mini-mester of spring and fall. And the micro-mester of Spring, Summer, and Fall semesters. Please note that there are limited seats per semester/mini-mester/micro-mester.

### **Class Times/Locations**

Classes are held **only** at the Butts County Center in Jackson and the Flint River Campus in Thomaston. Classes at the Flint River Campus are as follows: **Day** classes are taught from 8:30am until 4:00 pm, Monday through Thursday and are **8 weeks** long. **Weekend** classes are taught from 8:00am until 6:30pm Fridays and Saturdays and are **8 weeks** long. Classes in Butts County Center are as follows: **Day** classes are from 8:30am to 4:00 pm Monday thru Friday and are **4 weeks long**. **Night** classes are taught from 4:30pm until 10:00pm, Monday through Friday and are **8 weeks** long.

### **General Admissions Requirement (See admissions checklist)**

Upon admission to the college, students desiring to enter the CDL Program must fill out a separate CDL application and meet all program requirements.

### **Program Requirements**

Students must obtain the following before they will be registered for the CDL Program: CDL Learners Permit, DOT physical, and a 7-year MVR report (must be no more than 30 days old from submission date of CDL Program application). Students that have not completed all the above requirements will not be evaluated for the CDL selection process.

### **Candidate Selection**

Candidate selection is on a first come, first serve basis by the CDL application submission date. Each student must meet all general admissions requirements along with program requirements each semester.

### Acceptance

Students will be made aware of their acceptance to the CDL program via email. Once students have been accepted, they will be registered for the program. All selected students must attend Mandatory Orientation. Make sure that you have contacted Financial Aid regarding your balance before payment deadline.

### **Tuition and Fees**

The tuition for the CDL course is \$1,831.00. If you are eligible for Financial Aid, it may pay up to \$2,000.00 of the tuition leaving you with no out of pocket cost. (HOPE Grant = \$900 for 9 credit hours, Hope career Grant = 1,100 one-time lifetime award.) Please note that your balance must be paid in full by payment deadline. Other required out of pocket expenses would be your DOT physical, drug screen, CDL permit, and state testing fees.

<u>required</u> to receive any form of Financial Aid.

## FAQ's

### 1. How do I obtain my Permit and Physical?

- a. Obtain a CDL Drivers Manuel from any DDS. (You can also download a copy from the DDS website at www.DDS.gov) Study these three sections: General Knowledge, Combination Vehicles, and Air Brakes. While you are studying, obtain a D.O.T. physical. You will need to look on the National Registry of Certified Medical Examiners website for a location near you. The physical will need to be done prior to getting your CDL AP permit at the Department of Driver Services. Next, return to any DDS and take these tests.
- 2. Am I required to do a Drug Screening?
  - a. Yes, your drug screening will be administered at the mandatory orientation. Cost for this is \$100.00 paid to EZDOT at the mandatory orientation.
- 3. I do not think I will qualify for Financial Aid; do I have to complete FAFSA?
  - a. We suggest that all CDL students apply for Financial Aid.
