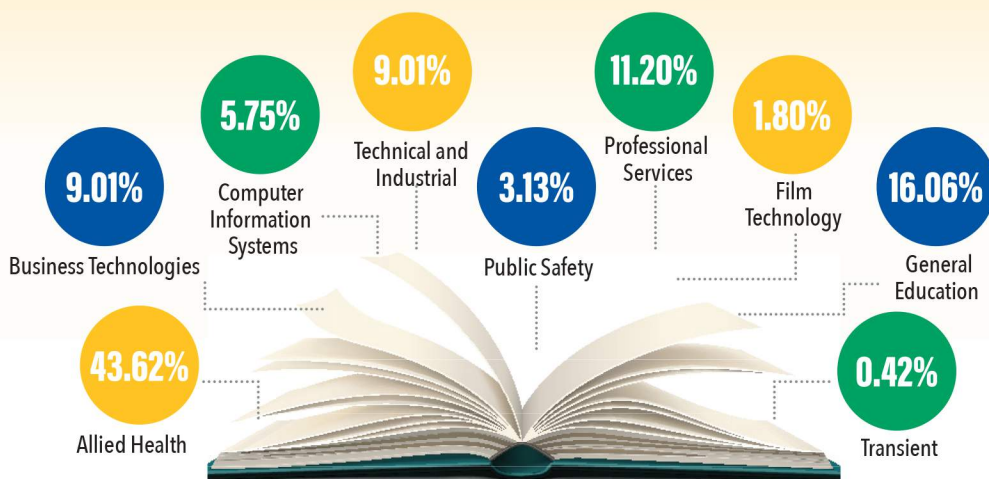

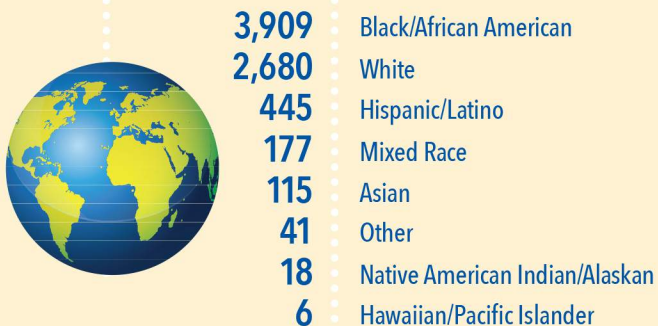

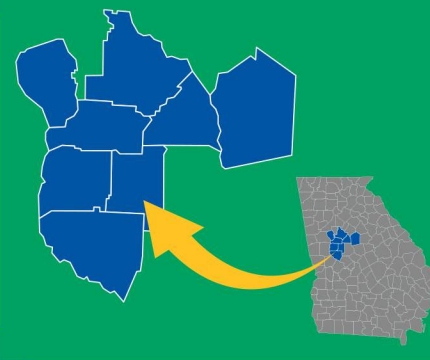


## RACE/ETHNICITY BREAKDOWN



## CREDIT ENROLLMENT BY COUNTY

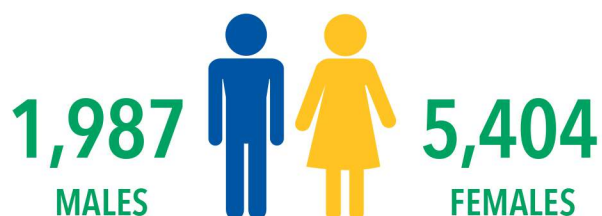
