OERs Pave the Way for Upcoming Zero Textbook Cost Courses

Southern Crescent Technical College (SCTC) is pleased to announce the introduction of Open Educational Resources (OERs) and Z-Courses within its Arts and Sciences division, beginning Spring Semester 2024. This important initiative seeks to revolutionize the educational landscape by providing students with free and accessible learning materials while enhancing the overall quality of education.

Open Educational Resources are educational materials that are openly licensed for anyone to use, adapt, and share freely. These resources include textbooks, multimedia content, assessment tools, and more and they are designed to provide an affordable and equitable solution to traditional, costly educational materials.

The introduction of Open Educational Resources has paved the way for Z-Courses, an exciting new initiative at SCTC. With the addition of OERs into the curriculum, students are now eligible to register for specific courses offered each semester that have been identified as Zero Textbook Cost courses or Z-Courses. Using OERs, there are no textbook costs associated with Z-Courses and will offer students a multitude of benefits such as significant cost savings, enhanced learning, increased accessibility, and inclusivity.

Kimberly Register, Vice President for Academic Affairs at Southern Crescent Technical College, expressed her enthusiasm for this transformative initiative saying, "We are excited to introduce **Open Educational Resources and Z-Courses within** our Arts and Sciences division. This initiative reflects our continued commitment to enhancing the educational experience for our students. OERs not only reduce the financial strain on our students, but also provide additional flexibility and empower instructors to innovate in their teaching methods. We believe that this move will create a more equitable and inclusive learning environment for all. Moving forward, we plan to further expand our Z-Course offerings using OERs."



In addition, SCTC is also implementing Low Cost Textbook Pathways (LTC) where required textbooks can be purchased for \$40 or less in either physical or electronic format. Similar to Z-Courses, LTC Pathways allow students to acquire supporting course materials at a deeply discounted rate. The implementation of OERs signifies a progressive step toward a more affordable and inclusive education, ensuring that students have the resources they need to excel in their academic journey. sctech.edu/Zcourses

The Southern Crescent Technical College Foundation recently hosted the Drive "Fore" Education Golf Tournament on November 2, 2023 at the Heron Bay Golf & Country Club in Locust Grove with 27 teams participating.

The Lauderdale style tournament was presented in partnership with Impact Office Interiors. Early estimates indicate that proceeds from the tournament will be in excess of \$57,000 with that money going to support the needs of the College including student scholarships and campus expansion.

SCTC President Dr. Irvin Clark expressed gratitude on behalf of the College and thanked the golfers in attendance before the 10 a.m. shotgun start. Dr. Clark stated, "Your attendance here today shows your commitment to the mission and purpose of Southern Crescent Technical College, and we cannot thank you enough for supporting our students and helping to make their career dreams a reality. We Tournament participants represented various business and industry partners from the College's eight county service area. United Bank took home top honors with a score of 19 under par. Double P Grading placed second with a score of 18 under par; Georgia Power finished third with a score of 17 under par. General Storage and Smith & Sons Funeral Home followed with a score of 13 under par.

LEARN MORE ABOUT Tutoring and Mentoring

The Tutoring and Mentoring Center at SCTC was designed to assist students in achieving their academic goals with in-person and virtual tutoring services. Tutors provide supplemental instruction in the areas of Math, English, Science and Reading, and are trained in learning strategies, including the study cycle to provide support to students in general work ethics and study skills. Additionally, all SCTC students, at all campuses and sites, have access to online tutoring services through Tutor.com. Tutor.com is an embedded tool link in all Blackboard courses offered at Southern Crescent Technical College. All tutoring services are free to SCTC students. The Tutoring and Mentoring Center completed 2,193 tutoring sessions in AY 23 with a 75% pass rate. This is a 36.6% increase in the number of tutoring sessions when compared to the previous year.
